EVENT INFORMATION

• All entries are online via Nominate entry system and are completed by the individual rider. Entries close on **Sunday**, **21 July 2024 at 11:00pm**.

- Each Club must submit a Pony Club WA Active Riding Qualifier Team Spreadsheet and Qualification Declaration. This must be endorsed by the Club President/Secretary and the Chief Coach/Coordinator by **Sunday**, **21 July 2024 at 11:00pm** to sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au.
- If a rider enters a class that is not endorsed by their Club, their entry will be deleted.
- The Chairperson and Committee members do not have authority to accept/forward late entries.
- Only PPMG Teams who participate in the Qualifier Event will be eligible to participate in the State Championships, unless an exemption is granted.
- The Active Riding Committee have included the opportunity for riders to participate in Novelties after their PPMG Championship Qualifier event. Each rider can have up to two runs at each of the five Novelty races. These are the same novelties that will be held at the 2024 Active Riding Championships. There will not be a Pony Club Mount at this event. We will be holding an Active Riding Challenge on Sunday at this event.
- Zones may use the State Active Riding Qualifier as their Zone Qualifying Event for Novelties.
- There will be a High Point for the Overall Winner and Runner-up in each of the three age groups: 12 years & under, 13-16 years and 17 years & over. The age of the rider is as at 01 January 2024. As there may be some younger riders competing in Novelties on Sunday, these awards will have to be calculated at the end of the Sunday competition and will be presented at the Active Riding State Championships.

ENTRY FEES AND LEVIES

PPMG Junior Rider / PPMG Open Rider	\$30 per Competitor
Novelties	\$20 per Competitor
First Aid Levy	\$15 per Competitor per Day
Serpentine Equipment Fee	\$10 per Horse per day
Camping Fee (payable if staying overnight)	\$10 per Family per night
Yards	\$10 for the weekend

A First Aid levy of \$15 per rider per day applies. The levy assists to cover the costs of having the qualified Medical crew on duty for the competition. The safety of our riders is a priority. A compulsory Ground Fee of \$10 per horse per day. A Camping Fee of \$10 per family per day.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Horse/Rider combinations must have completed a minimum of two rallies at the club they are representing in the 12 months prior to close of entries AND be signed off as competent by the Club Chief Coach and President. The definition of a working rally is in the current State Competition General Regulations.

CANTEEN

The canteen will be open on both days. Dinner will be available for purchase from the menu on Saturday between 4pm and 7pm.

YARDS

Yards are \$10 for the weekend per horse/pony. First in first served. Yards must be left clean and be free of manure and leftover feed.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

A **WWC Check** is required by a person if they engage in certain paid or unpaid work with children, described as 'child-related work' under the WWC Act.

Volunteers engaged in helper duties at Pony Club WA State Championships where the **usual duties** involve, or are they likely to involve, <u>contact</u> with a <u>child</u>, such as Team Manager, Gear Checking, Marshalling will be required to have a current WWCC unless a parent exemption applies. Parent exemption applies if you are volunteering and have a child under the age of 18 actively involved in the event you are volunteering at.

- To amend the placings awarded according to class numbers.
- To divide any class.
- To transfer competitors between classes.
- To alter the advertised times.
- To refuse any entry with a valid explanation.
