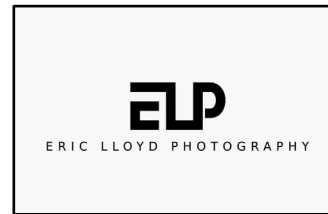

VENUE

Serpentine Horse and Pony Club is located at 1432 Karnup Road, Serpentine. The grounds play host to various equestrian community groups.

PONY CLUB WA – NO DOG POLICY

This is a Pony Club WA event, and the policy of **NO DOGS** will be strictly adhered to. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the elimination of rider(s).

Assistance animals approved by the Department of Local Government; Sport & Cultural Industries are exempt from this rule. Persons with an Assistance Animal may be requested to provide their approval documentation.

REFUNDS

As per the Pony Club General Regulations page 4, section 10:

Where a rider withdraws in accordance with rule 9:

- i). all levies will be refunded in full; and
- ii). entry fees shall be refunded in full (less a 20% administration fee) by Pony Club WA in the following circumstance:
 - a. where an entry is not accepted by Pony Club WA due to the total number of entries received exceeding the maximum capacity of the event/venue;
 - b. where a rider withdraws prior to close of entries;
 - c. where a Doctor's Certificate or a Veterinary Certificate is provided; or
 - d. where a team or pair is no longer eligible to participate due to a withdrawal as outlined above and a replacement cannot be found.

Requests for refunds must be forwarded to the Pony Club WA Office on the prescribed form, together with the required certificate (if applicable), within seven days following the competition.

Refunds may be subject to a \$20.00 administration fee.

E-SCOOTERS AND MOTORIZED BIKES

All care should be taken that these types of bikes are not causing disruption to competitors or spectators.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

A WWC Check is required by a person if they engage in certain paid or unpaid work with children, described as child-related work under the WWC Act. Volunteers engaged in helper duties at Pony Club WA State Championships where the usual duties involve, or are they likely to involve, contact with a child, such as Team Manager, Gear Checking, Marshalling will be required to have a current WWCC unless a Parent Exemption applies. A Parent Exemption applies if you are volunteering and have a child under the age of 18 actively involved in the event you are volunteering.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Neither the Organising Committee of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club Association of Western Australia accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

The Organising Committee reserves the right:

- To cancel any class or event.
- To amend the placings awarded according to class numbers.
- To divide or combine any class.
- To transfer competitors between classes.
- To alter the advertised times.
- To refuse any entry with a valid explanation.

CAMPING & YARDS

Camping is available on the grounds for \$10 per family (no powered sites).

Yards are available for a fee of \$10 per yard for the duration of the event.

Bookings for Camping and Yards were made through Event Secretary.

EVENING MEALS & CANTEEN

A full canteen will be provided over the weekend by Serpentine Horse & Pony Club.

A Saturday night dinner will be held. Dinner bookings were made through Event Secretary.

SWABBING

Pony Club WA adheres to a policy of random swabbing at our State competitions.

QUERIES & PROTESTS

1. Protests may be lodged against any person or body involved in any capacity in an Event or otherwise subject to the jurisdiction of Pony Club WA including for failure to observe the Constitution and By-Laws, Regulations or Rules or violation of the common principles of behaviour, fairness, or accepted standards of sportsmanship, whether occurring during or in connection with a Pony Club WA event or at any other time.
2. Any protest that concerns processes or behaviours, rather than outcome or result of a competition, are a general complaint as outlined in the Pony Club WA Complaints Policy.
3. Only the owner or his authorized agent, or the rider of a horse taking part in the competition or, in a team event, only the team manager is entitled to lodge an objection.
4. Protests must be in writing, signed by the person making the protest, and presented personally to the Event Secretary/ Technical Delegate/Steward together with any supporting evidence, names of witnesses and the necessary deposit of \$50.
5. Any person making a protest should, if possible, secure witnesses to the incident and any other form of evidence, and either brings them to the body before which the protest is lodged, or obtains written statements from them, duly signed, together with their names and addresses.
6. Any collection of evidence shall be in alignment with the Pony Club WA Member Protection Policy.
7. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, protests against any of the following matters may only be lodged with the Appeal Committee and, within the following time limits, a decision by the Hickstead Inspector/ Technical Delegate in these matters is a prerequisite to a right of appeal to the Appeal Committee:
 - 7.1 Protests concerning the eligibility of an Athlete or Horse or to the conditions of the arena: not later than 30 minutes before the start of the relevant competition.
 - 7.2 Protests concerning an obstacle, or the plan or length of the course for a jumping competition: not later than 15 minutes before the start of the competition.

7.3 Protests concerning cross country obstacles or courses in Hickstead: not later than 6 pm on the day before the relevant competition.

Protests concerning irregularities or incidents during a competition, or the classification of a competition: not later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results or the posting of results on the event notice board. Protest Form 2.

BRIEFING FOR CROSS COUNTRY JUMP JUDGES

There will be a briefing for all Cross-Country Jump Judges at 7:30am on Sunday morning in front of the Clubrooms.

This will be followed by a briefing with the crash crew and medical personnel.

TEAM MANAGERS

- The position of a Team Manager is classed as a part of a helper duty – they will be given a pack away duty as well. The Team Manager nominated may not be nominated for any other rider’s helper duty.
- Team Managers will be expected to attend all Team Manager meetings/briefings.
- Team Managers are expected to remain with their Team for the duration of each phase – gear check, warm up, competition.
- Team Managers are responsible for making all Team Members feel valued and important.
- Team Managers are responsible for making composite riders feel like a team.

- Team Managers to whom parent exemption does not apply MUST have a current Working with Children Check.
- Team Managers are expected to be conversant with the Role of a Team Manager outlined in the Pony Club WA Handbook: [Information for Team Managers](#)

HELPER DUTIES

- A helper needs to be provided for each horse/rider combination. No Self-Help is available.
- Volunteer helpers over the age of 18 that will be having contact with children in the line of their duty and to whom parent exemption does not apply MUST have a current Working with Children Check.
- Helper Duties will be between 3-4 hours duration. If your helper duty only takes an hour ie SJ Pack Away – you will be given other duties to make up the time.
- If you have multiple riders, you may be given 1 longer duty instead of two 3-4 hour duties where possible.
- Your helper duty might clash with your child's riding time – we apologise in advance but your Team Manager will be there to help your child.
- If you can't make your Helper Duty – it is your Club's responsibility to fill in for you.
- If you don't complete your Helper Duty – your rider will be eliminated.
- If you scratch prior to the event after the draw has been posted, it is your Club's responsibility to complete your helper duty.

CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

1. This event is to be run under the Current Pony Club WA Eventing Rules.
2. Eligible riders may compete on TWO different horses in two different grades, providing that both horses are duly qualified to compete. The SECOND nominated horse may NOT displace another rider who is entering their primary horse for that grade.
3. Each horse may only be ridden by one rider for the duration of the event.
4. Declaration of qualification and eligibility must be signed by the chief coach and an executive member of the rider's club will be required with all entry nominations for State Eventing Championships.
5. Riders' ages are from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the required age for the grade nominated. Required ages for each class are PC 110 - 14 years, PC 105 - 13 years, PC 95 - 12 years, PC 80 - 11years, PC 65 – 10 years, PC 45 – 9 years.
6. For State Eventing Championships there must be at least two judges per dressage arena for PC 110 & PC 105.
7. Teams of four or three Riders will be drawn for the competition. The best three (3) scores will be counted to make the team total. If entries are insufficient for a team competition in any grade, then teams of two or three will be drawn. In this case the best two (2) scores will be counted.
8. Clubs are not permitted to replace a horse/rider in a Club team with a horse/rider from a composite team after the draw has been published.
9. Plaiting is compulsory for the dressage phase of this event.

TEAM COMPOSITION

PC 65 / 80 CLUB TEAMS - for teams of three (3) or four (4) members and/or Associate members from the one club. If a club has more than 4 riders entered, the number of members per team shall always form the majority.

PC 95/105/110 CLUB TEAMS - for teams of three (3) or four (4) members and/or Associate members from the one club without restrictions on the number of associates competing. (If there are less than six (6) entries in any year teams of two (2) riders will be considered)

TEAM COMPOSITION Continued

NOTE: A club is permitted to enter more than one (1) Club Team provided such Club has a minimum of seven (7) qualified horse and rider combinations.

COMPOSITE TEAMS - for teams of three (3) or four (4) individual competitors comprising:
Additional members and/or senior members from clubs with teams already entered in Club Teams maximum of two (2) members and/or senior members from clubs NOT entered in Club Teams.
Additional members and/or senior members from clubs with teams already entered in Club Teams maximum of two (2) members and/or senior members from clubs NOT entered in Club Teams.

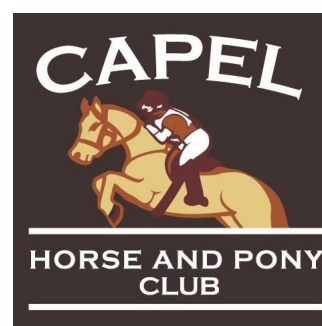
