

PONY CLUB WA CITIZENSHIP AWARD

ABOUT

The Pony Club WA Citizenship Award (formerly Shell and Vetsearch Award) commenced in 1994, was awarded to a Senior Riding Member of a Pony Club WA affiliated club who has given constant and practical services to their club.

ELIGIBILITY

The Senior Riding Member must have been a member of a Pony Club for at least three years.

If the nominee has been a member of another Pony Club affiliated with Pony Club WA, please state the name of club, length of membership and reason for changing club.

If the nominee has not been a member of your club for at least three years, a recommendation from the previous Chief Coach/President must be enclosed with this Nomination Form.

To be considered worthy of this award, the Senior Riding Member must:

- be helpful
- be courteous at all times
- be thoughtful
- be a positive role model for younger members
- uphold the Aims and Objectives of Pony Club WA at their club

Please note:

Riding ability and participation in teams, is irrelevant, and is not a determining factor when nominating a Senior Member for the Award.

A Senior Riding Member can only receive this award once.

NOMINATION PROCESS

Nominations for the Pony Club WA Citizenship Award are accepted and awarded annually by the Pony Club WA Board.

A Pony Club WA affiliated club must recommend the candidate/s for the award of Citizenship Award through the completion of the nomination form.

A club may nominate more than one Senior Riding Member for this award.

The form completed and signed by the nominating club must be presented to a meeting of the appropriate Zone.

The Zone Committee must then vote to endorse or reject the nomination. This can be done by circular resolution (email) or at a face-to-face meeting.

If the Zone does not endorse the nomination, they must cite evidence supporting that the criteria has not been met.

The form duly signed and dated by the Zone must be returned to the nominating club.

**The nominating club to submit the completed form to the General Manager of Pony Club WA.
The Pony Club WA Board will have the final decision on all State Awards.**

 - (d) in assisting, advising and encouraging other club members, and generally helpful in all the functions of the club
